From the Transitional Pastor's Desk



It confuses me that Christmas is always December 25 and Easter varies greatly based on the moon phases in the spring. This year Easter will be early, on March 31. Which means Ash Wednesday comes forty days before it on ... any guesses? Valentine's Day, February 14!

Ash Wednesday always begins our Lenten journey towards Jesus' Last Supper, Crucifixion, and Resurrection. We will have a service in our sanctuary on February 14 at noon to begin our Lenten journey with prayer and reflection. Members who want ashes on their forehead or hand in the shape of a cross may receive them.

During Lent I will lead a study of the book <u>Short Stories by Jesus</u> about the parables Jesus taught, especially understanding them through the eyes and ears of his disciples and first hearers, residents of the Holy



Land long ago. It will be offered in person in the morning and again by zoom in the evening. Watch the bulletin and Inspire for the days and how to get the zoom link.

During Lent our worship becomes a little more somber, the liturgical colors are purple and we start symbolically walking towards the Upper Room and Calvary. But stay tuned, the story does not end in Jesus' tomb! In late March we'll celebrate his resurrection.






