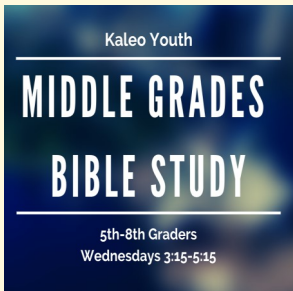

Students who attend the small group are asked to bring a Bible, mask (required), water bottle, and a blanket or towel to sit on.

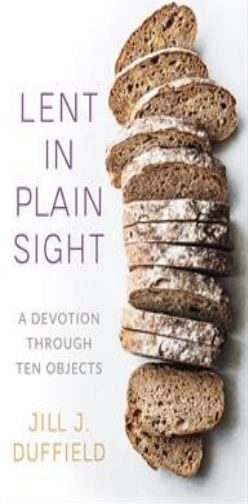
